## OUTDOOR LIGHTING AGREEMENT (Single Unit)

This agreement, made and entered into this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_\_ by and between Washington Electric Cooperative, Inc. (hereinafter called the "Seller"), and \_\_\_\_\_ (hereinafter called the "Consumer") mutually agree as follows:

1. Seller will furnish, install, operate, maintain, and own an outdoor lighting unit at a location suitable to both the Consumer and the Seller.
2. Seller will furnish electricity for the lighting unit which shall be controlled by a photocell.
3. All maintenance will be limited to maintenance crew's normal working hours, and performed at the earliest convenience of the Seller.
4. The consumer will pay, prior to installation of any lighting equipment, the installation charges as provided in Schedule OL in effect at the time of this agreement.
5. Consumer will be billed and pay for the foregoing service in accordance with Schedule OL and as amended by action of the Board of Trustees or other regulatory authorities.
6. Consumer will allow authorized representatives of Seller to enter upon Consumers' premises to trim trees and shrubs as necessary for maintenance of the lighting unit and for removal of the lighting unit and pole upon termination of service under this agreement.
7. Consumer will exercise all possible precaution in protecting the lighting unit from damage. Seller reserves the right to remove the unit if maintenance persists as a result of vandalism, and such removal will terminate this agreement.
8. It is understood that the lighting unit remains the property of Seller and may be removed at the discretion of Seller if the Consumer fails to keep any of the conditions stated in this agreement.
9. It is understood that in cases where the pole is the property of the Consumer, the Seller reserves the right to refuse installation or to remove the lighting unit if the Consumer-owned pole is found to be in bad or hazardous condition.
10. This agreement shall become effective on the date the lightning unit is installed and shall remain in effect for a period of one year and thereafter until terminated by either party giving notice to the other.
